### Parents can talk to a lawyer before answering any questions

Parents facing a child protection investigation can talk to a lawyer before answering any questions. You can tell the social worker "I need to talk to a lawyer about that" instead of answering their questions right away.



# Parents who are or were in foster care have access to special lawyers

Young parents currently in foster care can call 323-523-3105 or 626-670-0584, and parents previously in foster care can call 866-435-1455 to be connected to free, confidential legal support.



# Anything you tell the social worker can end up in a court report

The social worker will document everything you say, which may be told to the judge who decides if you can care for your children. Whenever possible, talk to a lawyer about your legal rights before you talk to the social worker.
